of the minor and major prophet books in the context of Israel's history. This month I have read Jonah, Isaiah, Amos, Micah, and Hosea while continuing to read through Psalms, 2 Kings, and 2 Chronicles. God is very clear throughout these books that our sin is cause for His judgment and Jesus' sacrifice the only way God redeems our relationship with Him.

I am currently reading through Acts. Acts contains one of my favorite aspects of the church; doing life together! My prayer for many years had been Acts 2:42-47. We as a launch team having been doing trainings after our studies on Sunday. A few weeks ago we headed out on the streets of the city to share the gospel. One of our launch team members shared the gospel with someone in their tribal language and he came to know the Lord!

We are continuing to meet with those who have signed up to join Mercy's launch team and a young man felt in his heart that he had not truly excepted salvation; Jordan and Allan walked through what it meant to be a follower of Christ and Sam came to know the Lord that meeting!



Last Sunday we were blessed to meet the whole family of one of our members, Niko. He was able to bring his wife and 3 daughters. The youngest is only 3 months old. We were able to welcome and pray over them as parents. We are excited to see Mercy grow not only in salvations but families growing.



Our building is still under renovations; pray for a timely completion and for our NGO to be excepted by the government soon!

We have been in the process of interviewing potential worship leaders. Currently I, Tori, have been leading us in worship through Spotify. We are excited that through prayer and many conversations, we have offered the role to a band member from Bible Study last year! We are currently waiting to hear back from him and when he can start!



We held another outreach and this one was different than our previous ones. In the past, we have fed around 200 people. That allowed us to feed many people but it did not provide space to hold conversations. We are getting closer to opening Mercy House and are prayerfully considering which women we can serve. So we hosted at the YMCA and invited around 15-20 women that we have built relationships with over the past four months. Since it was a smaller crowd, we were able to sit and have conversations with the women. It also gave us an opportunity to share the Gospel with them. Salome did an incredible job leading a devotion in Swahili.



Please continue to pray for wisdom and clarity as we plan and implement our monthly outreaches.



I have been given my job description for Mercy House and I am VERY excited about it. I will be planning and implementing the kids program. I, Rachel, have been working on researching curriculums and daily devotionals that will be best for the children we are serving. After a Mercy house out reach I went over to the Kohmans and spent time with new friends from their neighbourhood bonfires. It was encouraging to play games and talk about Jesus.




We have game nights with the Kohmans on Monday nights. Before they left for Spain we finished an on going game of mexican train. I love these sweet evenings with them.
