Scripture Reading

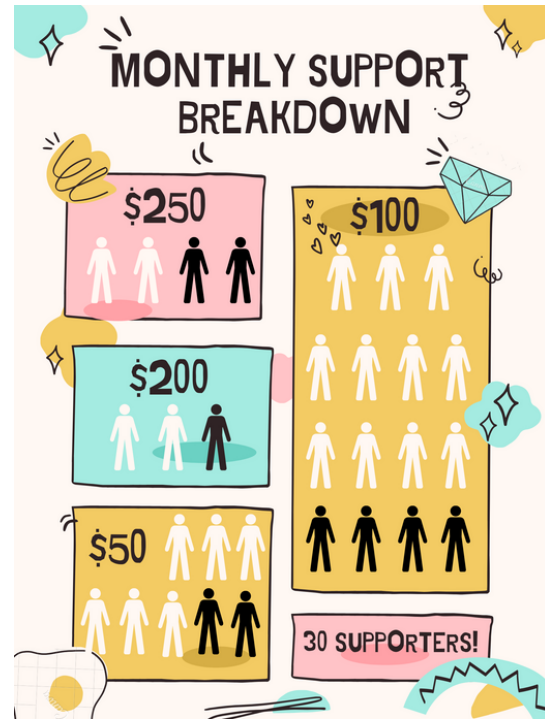
I have been reading through Exodus. It has been a great reminder that God cares for His people and is a faithful deliverer even when we doubt and question Him.
